All proposals should include the following information:

- Title of presentation
- Subject area
- Brief program objective
- Target audience
- Length of presentation (See pg 3)
- Type of presentation (See pg 3)
- Abstract - Approximately 100-word description of your presentation
- Presentation history: has this been presented before and will it be presented again?
- Presenter biographical information, including:
 - Name(s) of presenters, company, title, contact information
 - Number of years in home care or relevant experience
 - Detailed speaking experience, resume and biography
 - Speaker's Fee (if applicable)

Proposal Format:

- Please submit all proposals as .doc files.

Proposal Deadlines:

- Submissions for webinars and specialty programs will be reviewed throughout the year.
- The deadline for 2025 Conference submissions is **March 14, 2025**.

Under no circumstances should an HCPF presentation be a sales pitch for a specific company or product.
